3. In case of false/wrong declaration or fabricated documents have been used for procuring permissions of MARB and any misconduct is brought to the notice of National Medical Commission or **found during surprise assessment at any stage during the current academic year, your institution is liable, not to be considered for recognition of that degree.** This letter of permission will be revoked for the current academic year if such exigency arises.
